Bringing together leading academic thinkers, civil society organizations and activists, and practitioners and experts from across Europe, the GEM-DIAMOND **Policy Agora Forum & Citizen Innovation Lab** on **Democracy and Dissensus** will grapple with the origins, drivers, dynamics and impacts of *dissensus* on European democracy, with special focus on Fundamental Rights & The Rule of Law and Autonomy of the Judiciary; Exercising Democracy – Civil Society and Challenges to Democratic Space; Contested Spaces – Gender, Power & Fundamental Rights; and The Role of Academia in Dissensus & Democracy.

The initial *Orientation and Training Workshops* will offer the fellows an opportunity to secure the latest information on the program's ongoing implementation, ask any questions they might have at this stage, and receive a specific skills training session dedicated to the question of how researchers are to write scientifically informed policy recommendations.

The *Agora* methodology will create a dynamic and engaging space for academics, practitioners, and policy makers to discuss together, critically reflecting and diving into and analyzing key issues and challenges, with invited experts from across Europe and the three focal countries: Poland, Hungary, and Romania. It involves a series of highly participatory and dynamic sessions with engagement from everyone aimed at meeting different excellent experts and civil society actors associated with democratic activism at the local level, as well as the wider struggle to uphold fundamental rights and the rule of law thus helping the fellows to unpack the role of different actors, be they challengers or champions of liberal democratic norms and practices.

The *Citizen Innovation Lab* will take a *solution-based approach* on how to address and respond to these challenges while innovating more authentic, effective, just and inclusive democratic practices and polities in Europe.
